We discussed the meeting Lauren attended of the St Johnsbury Center Cemetery Assn last month. There's been no further communication re their plans or status. Lauren will follow up with Laura.

Lauren spoke about an email from Sheila Brown of Barre whose recently deceased dad (James Houston) had a headstone at the Grove Cemetery, next to her deceased mom (Madeline Houston). His final wishes were to be buried with other family in Cabot, hence no need for the headstone. Lauren will notify her re our bylaws that the sexton must be notified when any work is to be done in the cemetery.
