

# Pleasant Street & Gilman Avenue Neighborhoods Water, Sewer and Storm Improvements Project September 2022 Project Update

- Farmer Drive/Gilman Avenue Area
  - The culvert replacement is nearly complete. The connection between Farmer Drive and Gilman Ave should be restored soon.
  - Due to ledge, blasting is required along Farmer Drive and is scheduled to begin on 9/26 and is expected to last about a week. This will allow the completion of the utility installation.
  - Farmer Drive and Lawrence Circle will have all utilities installed before winter but will likely be left as gravel surfaces until spring.
- Pleasant Street Area
  - Temporary pavement of trenches will be completed on School Street. No additional utility installation on School Street and Orient Street are planned for this construction season.
  - New sidewalk on the west side of Pleasant Street will have gravel surface installed but no new concrete until spring.
- What to expect this winter
  - All streets will have the base course of asphalt except for Farmer Drive and Lawrence Circle.
  - Driveways and walkways will be temporarily tied into the new street.
  - General cleanup and removal of equipment and materials.
- What to expect in the spring
  - Completion of water, sewer and storm utility installation on School Street.
  - Bioretention swale installation throughout the project area.
  - Raising of manholes, catch basins and valve boxes.
  - Sidewalk installation and patching.
  - Final driveway and yard restoration.
  - Final paving throughout the project.
  - Completion by August 2023.
