Update on Final Rule:

- Final rule established an exemption where the town can declare total ARPA award as revenue loss. Funds become surplus funds and can be used for any governmental spending and no longer needs to fall within the previously established spending categories. Opens up flexibility.
- Previously infrastructure was only eligible for water, sewer and broad band, but now could be used for any infrastructure.
- ARPA Funds will be used to cover existing expenses already budgeted for, and the taxes gathered will result in a surplus in the General Fund. General Funds will then be considered local funds and can be used as matching funds in programs that require nonfederal match.

Prioritization Process Discussion:

- Discussion on short term needs, such as emergency funding to assist businesses in need. Suggest that technical assistance for businesses, such as the NCIC technical assistance program be looked at in the long term.
- Micro Business Development Program has funds available for emergency business needs.
- Previous list included short term emergency needs, to include the Cherry Street/Railroad Street Buildings in the amount of \$150,000 and the Main Street Fire Site project in the amount of \$50,000.
- Reviewed the current priority list to identify short term/emergency needs.

- Group discussed \$200,000 of funding for Rural Edge to support redevelopment of Cherry Street and Railroad Street vacant and blighted properties as well as \$50,000 towards the Main Street Fire Site, both of which address priorities within the Town Plan, VRCD Community Visit and leverage approximately \$10M of additional funds.
- Warming Shelter and dealing with Homelessness have also been prioritized in the VRCD document and has immediate impacts on St Johnsbury's downtown.
- Group discussion to identify what emergency needs are and to set up a process to identify emergencies and make a recommendation to the select board to address these items. The group discussed that all requests for the use of ARPA funds should come through the ARPA Committee to prevent requests popping up without Committee involvement.

• Group had consensus that these two projects have immediacy and meet priorities established by the Town Plan and the VRCD Community Visit and felt that they should be treated separately and outside of the new process currently under development and should be presented to the Select Board with recommendations to move forward.

• Next steps to gather public input are to release an RFP for Facilitators.
