Bryan moved to have Chad see if the neighbor to the Grove Cemetery is willing to open and close the gate as was done last year. Seconded by Lauren. Bryan and Lauren voted in favor. Andy opposed.

Lauren provided a summary of the meeting of the VT Cemetery Assn which she attended on May 2. Andy moved that we join the Old Cemetery Assn. This will allow us to apply for one of their grants to help with the costs of repairing and cleaning some of the old and poorly maintained stones in some of our cemeteries. This discussion will be continued at our next meeting.

Andy also moved, seconded by Bryan to reimburse Lauren for the cost of attending the meeting including mileage. Approved unanimously.
