Working communities grant. NEK collaborative, working on grant application for 300k, Working Communities. Housing Commt., grants for building improvements, awarded in Mar., Apr. Code compliance, revenue YTD, 40k. Continuing work by ZA for landlord compliance. CUD, voters to decide in Mar., whether to join. Parking enforcement, Bob Holmes continues to do parking enforcement. Property re-appraisal, still on going. Construction projects, winter hold. New Ave apartments, redevelopment continues with hazardous materials abatement.
