Planning Commission meeting

- 1. Convene Meeting. 7:05
- 2. Agenda changes. Chair suggested moving #10 up to #7, due to other participants all interested in #10. Motion by Larry, 2nd by Ed. Motion Passed.
- 3. Public Comment. Chair clarified, public comment was for anything not already on the agenda. No comments.
- 4. Minutes approval, 3/15/2022. Larry motion, 2nd by Ed, to approve minutes with noted changes, additions.
- 5. Manager's Report. Discussed a few of the current town events, changes, new construction.
- 6. ZA Report. Spoke about vacant structures, E911, storage facilities, food trucks.
- 7. Cannabis retail sales. Zoning changes needed. Discussed model language definition, possible zones, when first retail sales can occur, Cole Memorandum, Cannabis Control Board, VT rules and regs, checking I.D.'s, testing product, geographical distribution of retail cannabis shops, possible nest steps of growing processing. PC will be making decisions at May 17th meeting for public hearing.
- 8. Bylaws regarding sign lighting, DCD, updating the details. Possible changes to bylaws. Updates and clean copy. Next steps. Ed made good presentation. Ready at May 17th meeting for final copy, decisions for public hearing.
- 9. NFIP, FEMA, CAC related updates, more work to be done. Chair will forward FEMA, CAC list of need to be added to bylaws. Ben not available, no further discussion.
- 10. Homelessness. Zoning changes needed. Continued discussion concerning homeless shelter zones, possibly to include RL1, RL2, RT, Mixed Use, Commercial, Health Services. Temporary overnight shelter definition already includes language to directly consider homeless shelters.
- 11. Other business. Ed presented an issue concerning signs, whereas there appears to be 2 tiers of signs, i.e., those that have taken all the necessary steps according to zoning bylaws, and those signs that just appear in places without any DAC, DRB, approvals. Steps ought to be taken to prohibit the latter, encourage the former.
