# Rental Housing Improvement Program: Presented by Joe Kasprzak

- Joe reviewed revisions A point was added to the scoring system if an award was not received in the previous year.
- Request for \$14,751.00 of rental registry program to be allocated to the Rental Housing Improvement Program.
- Use \$10,000 from Economic Development reserves to supplement.
- Bernie Timson asks if a surplus over \$42,000 goes back into the General Fund or could it offset \$35.00 registration fee, which may make landlords happy.
- Jeff motioned to authorize ATM to proceed with program and to use up to \$10,000 of Economic Development reserve and up to \$20,000 of fees, over and above \$22,000 of fees collected, second by Tim. All were in favor.
