## **Town of St. Johnsbury Notice of Public Hearing**

The Town of St. Johnsbury is considering making application to the State of Vermont for an Implementation Grant under the Vermont Community Development Program. A public hearing will be held at 6:00pm on February 22, 2021 to obtain the views of citizens on community development, to furnish information concerning the amount of funds available and the range of community development activities that may be undertaken under this program, the impact to any historic and archaeological resources that may be affected by the proposed project, and to give affected citizens the opportunity to examine the proposed statement of projected use of these funds. The proposal is to apply for \$500,000 in VCDP Funds which will be used to accomplish the following activities: *planning, preparation, and remediation of hazardous materials at 1249 Main Street commonly referred to as the Armory. These efforts will prepare the Armory to be redeveloped into a Police Department and Dispatch Center.*
