## Audit Presentation By Sullivan Powers and Company:

- Chad Whitehead, Town Manager explained that the audit report is available on the Town website and hard copies are available for the Select Board if they wish.
- Rick Brigham from Sullivan Powers and Company presented the Select Board with the annual audit review.
- He explained that there are three options for the auditor's opinion the Town was given the unqualified opinion. He explained that a lot of work went into the audit and thanked Finance, the Town Clerk/ Treasurer, the Select Board, and Town Manager's Office.
- Reviewed the Town's financial position as of June 30<sup>th</sup>. Rick explained that the Town is overall in pretty good shape and no concerns were noted. Reserves are at fairly healthy levels at this time.
- Overall the Town of St. Johnsbury saw an increase in fund balances and hit expenditures.
- The Town continues to follow the Town Pension Plan and VMERS requirements.
- No compliance issues were noted during the audit. The internal controls letter showed no significant findings and no material weaknesses.
- The town has good reliable systems in place and Sullivan Powers and Company have no recommendations. There were no difficulties or disagreements with management during the audit.
- No questions or comments for from board or the public.
- Frank mentioned that it was pretty straight forward.
- Rick mentioned that it was one of the first audits out the door because of the preparation from staff before the audit.
- Frank thanked everyone that had an impact on the audit.
- Chad thanked Rick and Sullivan Powers and Company. Thanked Lesley, Stacy, and Rachel for their hard work along with department heads. He explained that a clean audit takes a lot of work throughout the year and thanked everyone for all their help.
- Frank thanked Rick.
