

St. Johnsbury Cemetery Commission
June 12, 2025

The St. Johnsbury Cemetery Commission met at the town conference room. In attendance were Bryan LeBlanc, Tim Cloutre, Lauren Järvi, Karen Budde and Chad Whitehead.

Meeting called to order by Lauren at 8:02 AM.

Bryan moved to approve the minutes from our May 8 meeting. Seconded by Tim. Approved by B & T.

Karen reported that she has obtained a marker from the VA for Mr. Cyr's grave and also located a numbered marker that can be used to identify the location of his grave. The matter of the Eaton burial at Grove continues to be a challenge. Karen will follow up with some family members re whether in fact Mrs. Eaton was relocated to Derby. She has presided over several full and urn burials and has more scheduled. Sam is continuing to maintain the data base that is getting ever more accurate and useful.

No decision was made on a schedule for marker cleaning and maintenance until the outstanding work on the hydrangeas etc at Centervale has been completed.

Tim made a motion to contract with Lincoln Sign Company to make signs for our two cemeteries currently without them, Ayer-Hawkins and Centervale. Seconded by Bryan. Andy had made contact with this sign company and provided details on what we want, consistent with what was made several years ago for CVBY and Grove. The Estimate is for \$1,926.40 with a 50% deposit. Approved by T&B. Lauren will confirm this with LSC and this project should proceed.

Tim has not yet been successful in his effort to locate a member of the Dillon family re their family monument at the Grove. Karen may step in see if she has other resources to move this along.

Bryan moved to adjourn at 8:39. Seconded by Bryan Approved by B & T.
