The St. Johnsbury Cemetery Commission met at the town conference room. In attendance were Tim Clouatre, Lauren Järvi, Karen Budde and Andy Dussault

Meeting called to order by Lauren at 8:02 AM.

Tim moved to approve the minutes from our October 9 meeting. Seconded by Lauren. Approved by T & L.

Additional fall clean-up at our cemeteries was done primarily by Karen, along with some DPW staff. Hydrangeas at Centervale were trimmed and lots were marked. The gate at Grove has been locked for the winter, and Karen reported on exploring getting a similar gate for Centervale for next year. She'll see that DPW moves the barriers across the entrance there this fall.

The Dillon memorial at Grove has been moved to the front of the family lot and now aligns with the others in the same row along the road.

The signs for Centervale and Ayer-Hawkins are coming along. We expect to hear soon that they are completed and ready to be picked up, in Littleton. We'll request that DPW send someone to do this.

We discussed the FY27 budget and understand that there will likely be an increase in what DPW charges us for mowing and maintenance. This will need to be incorporated into our budget along with an additional amount for monument cleaning and maintenance.

Tim moved to adjourn at 8:29, seconded by Lauren. Approved by T&L.
