 1. How does the committee/Town feel the following three use and management objectives should be prioritized:
 - a. Recreation- trails, views, etc
 - b. Natural resource/ecological conservation, habitat protection
 - c. Active management (agriculture and forestry)
 2. Are there any use restrictions outside of those in the Easement the committee is contemplating (i.e. bikes, dogs, hunting, etc)
 3. We're considering a site walk with the committee (or one or two members) to learn more about the property, its features, and history. Would you like to propose some scheduling options and we can see how it fits our availability?
 4. A cultural resources review was mentioned- can someone send this to us?
 5. If you have local names for any locations, points of interest, or trails that are already existing, or can share notable features, wildlife sightings, etc, that would all be helpful to know. I'll set up an online map tool for you to mark-up locations on the property we should know about. I'll get that link to you before your May meeting.
 6. What does the Committee envision for public engagement components, how would you most like to engage the community in this planning effort? How do you think the most relevant and robust information can be gathered from your constituents?
 - a. Walks? Workshops?
 - b. Public meetings?
 - c. Another survey?
 - d. Other?

Note- 'We [Arrowwood] suggested asking the farmer to hold haying on the property until after July 15th if possible. I believe Chad suggested he would do so.'
